A Dallas Tradition in Historic West End

The West End Pub's 20 plus year history is a story of people more than liquor and food. The exact dates and actual times of occurrences are about as clear as a glass of Ugly Pug Black Lager and actually as important as the true ingredients of Jagermeister. It is the outcome that is important.

It was all started in the early 1988 by Mike Vascuso when the original name was to be the Wall Street Pub (i.e. the Statue of Liberty). Due to legalities and fate it became the West End Pub. Single Malt Scotches, imported cigars, fresh squeezed juices, and no food were all part of the plan. When the Pub opened in March 1988 the juices were gone and a small food menu added. The first paying customer was Rodney Mills and he is still paying 20 years later.

Bob Allen, already a familiar face in the West End, became part of the Pub 6 months later and the history began. One year from opening Mike was gone and Chip Johnson (one of the original developers in the West End) and Bob took over. The "Neighborhood Pub without the Neighborhood" was created and continues today. During this era the fresh squeezed juices returned and remain today, the food menu grew (the chicken salad became World Famous), and the "living room" appeared. The groundwork for the next 20 years was set in place.

Four years later Bob became the sole owner but Chip's presence was still and always will be part of the success of the Pub.

Over a decade ago Earl Shuster joined the cast of characters. Having managed one of the most successful restaurants in the area a couple years before, he eventually became part owner of the pub. Changes have continued, most recently a change of location (who said bigger wasn't better), but the Single Malts, Cigars, fresh-squeezed juices, the living room (now two), the largest free pour shot in the area, and the Statue of Liberty still remain. (Oh yeah, and Mark). We are always here to greet our friends as well as the traveler seeking a "Neighborhood Pub without a Neighborhood"
